



The **COMMIT Support Partnership** is a legal entity under the NATO Support and Procurement Organization (NSPO). It is set up to provide for the joint management of NATO common items, with the aim of collectively improving materiel management support for its Member States and for NATO as a whole.

Joint management of items can range from:

- ad-hoc redistribution of assets in excess of needs
- to joint virtual stock management
- and replenishment of consolidated requirements through internationally competed contracts

NLSE

- The NATO Logistics Stock Exchange (NLSE) is a set of tools developed by NSPA to assist customers and suppliers in putting into practice cooperative logistics concepts for items acquisition and management. These tools allow customers to arrange for the exchange of materiel and to provide the basis for establishment of joint visibility to facilitate exchanges.
- The NLSE information system platform consists of a set of databases and a web-based interface. The databases contain logistics information about parts, customers' stockholdings and present and future requirements, as well as details of commercial suppliers and what they can offer. The web interface provides an easy way for customers and suppliers to access and exchange information in a secure, controlled manner.

ASSET VISIBILITY

National Armed Forces report inventory periodically (monthly/quarterly) in the NLSE system. This key information provides the foundation for cooperative logistics by:

- Establishing joint visibility
- Identifying potential redistributions
- Consolidation of requirements
- Improving codification (ID duplicate NSNs)
- Managing the activities of the User Groups

Provides:

- Greater material availability
- Reduced lead time
- Alternative sourcing

ASSET REDISTRIBUTION

Selling Material
